

Code of Conduct

All applicants are expected to abide by the Code of Conduct as follows:

1. The Scout Oath and Law and the Outdoor Code will be my guide throughout the course.
2. I will set a good example by keeping myself neatly dressed and presentable.
3. I will attend all scheduled programs and participate, as required, in cooperation with other unit members and leaders.
4. I will do my share to prevent littering of the **Circle Ten Council** campgrounds and **"Leave No Trace."**
5. I understand that the purchase, possession, or consumption of alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs is prohibited.
6. Serious and/or repetitive behavior violations by youth, including use of tobacco, cheating, stealing, dishonesty, swearing, fighting, and cursing may result in expulsion from Oak Leaf or serious disciplinary action and loss of privileges.
7. I understand that possession of lasers of any type along with the possession or detonation of fireworks is prohibited.
8. I will demonstrate respect for unit, Oak Leaf **and Circle Ten Council** property and be personally responsible for any loss, breakage, or vandalism of property as a result of my actions.
9. All applicants are prohibited from having firearms or weapons in their possession except for knives in accordance with BSA policy and the possession of your Totin' Chip card.
10. Hazing **and bullying** has no place in Scouting, nor do running the gauntlet, belt lines, or similar physical or **mental** punishment.
11. Serious violation of this code may result in expulsion from Oak Leaf. All decisions will be final.
