

Do I need to bring a backpack?

No, the campsites are less than a half mile from the check-in station. A duffle bag will work just fine. However, it would be easier to carry all of your gear in a backpack.

Can I tent with someone from my troop?

No. We purposely divide the scouts up so they won't be together with other scouts they know. This gives the youth the opportunity to become more diversified and to grow.

What time is Graduation?

10:30 am Sunday morning.

What if my son has special dietary needs?

Please email the course director with specific requirements so we can accommodate him.

Can my son sleep by himself?

Yes, if he feels comfortable by himself, although it's discouraged.

Can I bring my son late or pick him up early?

Yes, but it is not recommended. He needs to be there the required time to complete the course.

If my son can't attend this course, when is the next one?

There are two courses offered yearly, one in the spring and one in the fall.

My son is almost 12. Can he still attend?

A scout attending needs to be 12 at the time of the course.

Is food provided?

Saturday dinner, dessert and Sunday breakfast will be provided. He needs to bring a sack lunch for Saturday.

What if registration is closed? Can I be put on a waiting list? Can I show up?

The registration is based on the number of staff that has volunteered. You may request to be put on a waiting list for the first available opening if the course is closed. If you show up to the event without being registered, there is a chance that the scout will be turned away.

Can my son staff Oak Leaf?

The course is staffed by volunteer older scouts. There are many entry level positions. Contact the Course Director for more information.
