Participants may register for this event on-line from the website. You will need to know unit number and shirt size for each person. Adults will also need to know the date on their YPT (Youth Protection Training) card.

- Only those registering on-line by 9/18 are guaranteed an event T-shirt (uniform of the day)
- Only staffing units will be allowed to camp on Friday night.
- A chuck wagon lunch will be provided on Saturday.
