

# North Trail Redistricting Transition

On 1/1/12, as far as Circle Ten is concerned, North Trail District will officially no longer exist. From a functionality standpoint, this is not actually correct and it will not happen overnight. As volunteers, we need to know what is going to happen and how it's going to happen in order to make the transition as seamless as possible for scouts and unit leaders.

Last spring, council approved the district calendar which runs through the end of the 2011-12 academic year. As many of the activities on the calendar require long range advance planning and/or include reservations at Circle Ten camp facilities, *the following activities will continue as currently planned*; District Dinner, Scouting For Food, Camporee, Spring outdoor training (BALOO/OWLS/OLS/Oak Leaf/BAT, etc.), Rendezvous and Twilight Camp. The North Trail website ([www.northtrail.org](http://www.northtrail.org)) will continue to function at least through the end of Twilight Camp, as a portal for these continuing activities.

All three North Trail heritage districts have appointed or are in the process of appointing district committee nominating committees. It is hoped that very soon, at least the key three (District Chair, District Commissioner and District Executive) of each new district will be ready to assume their positions, if not the entire committee. Names for the newly formed districts are currently being solicited from Scouts and Scouters.
